Call for Nominations for SEMCE(I) Awards 2008 & 2009

The Society of EMC Engineers (India) invites nominations for the SEMCE(I) Awards (a) **EMC ENGINEER OF THE YEAR** for the year 2008 & 2009 and (b) **YOUNG EMC ENGINEER OF THE YEAR** for the year 2008 & 2009. Nominations close on 9th October 2010 (Saturday). Forms are available in SEMCEI web site.

1. SEMCE(I) Award:

The SEMCE(I) Award recognizes outstanding achievements amongst its members and other professionals in the area of EMC and related subjects through this annual award. The description of award along with selection criteria and nomination procedure are outlined here. Nominations are invited as per standard nomination form available in web site.

2. Award Description:

The award is given annually to a person or a group of persons for outstanding contributions in the field of EMC covering education, research, design development and / or production. The awards (a) and (b) carry a cash reward of Rs. 20,000/- and Rs. 10,000/- respectively along with a certificate and citation to be read out at a special function of the SEMCE(I).

3. Selection Criteria:

The award is generally open for Indian nationals for the work done by them in India. The contributions, achievements of the nominee should have the potential of significant impact on future developments in India in the respective fields recognized for the award. The contributions of the nominee should be properly documented and verifiable. The nominee should have demonstrated potential for creative output. No self nomination will be considered. For the Young EMC Engineer of the Year Award, the age of the nominee should be less than 35 years as on 31 Dec. 2009.

4. Nomination Procedure:

Nominations for the award can be made by heads of academic / scientific institutions, R & D labs (ISRO/CSIR/DRDO/DOT/DOE,etc.), Indian Army / Navy / Air Force, Government Bodies, Professional Societies, Industry and Members of SEMCE(I).

The nomination should be made in the nomination form enclosed and all information has to be concise and confined to the allotted space. The proposed citation (limited to 25 words) should be included in the space provided in the form. Absence of citation may disqualify the nomination. The nomination form completed in all respects, together with a list of all scientific / technical publications, if any should be sent before the due date in a sealed cover marked "confidential" to the following address.
